## Rejoice and Be Glad in Each and Every Day

#### This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. (Psalm 118:24)

These past few weeks we have experienced some intense winter weather. We have had multiple winter storm advisories. We have had days where the temperature didn't reach above zero. We have had multiple inches of snow. It's during these days that we might say, "I can't wait until it gets warmer." But even during the warmer months we still can complain about how hot and humid it can be. We can have intense summer storms that bring inches of rain which causes flooding. The reality is that no matter what the weather may be like we are not always content.

But the above passage tells us to rejoice and be glad in each and every day. But why is that? There are multiple reasons to rejoice and be glad in each and every day. First, it's because it's the day the Lord has made. At creation the Lord created different things on each day. Although the Lord has stopped creating he still takes care of his creation. In his wisdom the Lord does different things on different days. Therefore some days may be cold and others may be warm. Some days may be full of sunshine and other days may have snow or rain. The Lord decides what will happen on each day in order to accomplish his purpose. Even if we don't fully understand why, we have the confidence that this is what the Lord wants.

A second reason to rejoice and be glad in each and every day is because each and every day is another day to experience the Lord's grace and blessings. Every day the Lord brings us different blessings, whether it's the continuation of certain blessings like what we need for our lives or it's new blessings the Lord gives to us. This is why we rejoice and are glad in each and every day because the Lord will take care of us and bless us according to his love.

A third reason to rejoice and be glad in each and every day is if you look at the context of this passage. In the context of this passage it talks about Jesus as the capstone which the builders have rejected. Then it mentions that the Lord has done this and it is marvelous in our eyes. Why would the rejection of Jesus be a marvelous thing to us? It's because Jesus came to be rejected and put to death in order to take away our sins. That's the ultimate day that the Lord had made: the day of our salvation. Therefore we rejoice and are glad in each and every day because if the Lord hated us and distanced himself from us then each and every day would be a day of sorrow and despair, but instead we constantly live under the Lord's grace and salvation.

So as we continue on in these winter months when the weather may not be the best, rejoice and be glad in the day the Lord has made knowing that in his wisdom he makes every day special, the Lord blesses us each and every day, and we live under his grace and salvation.


