Back to the Word

When men tell you to consult mediums and spiritists, who whisper and mutter, should not a people inquire of their God? Why consult the dead on behalf of the living? To the law and to the testimony! (Isaiah 8:19-20a)

It is August and we begin to realize that summer is almost over, which means children will be going back to school soon. Stores are having their back-to-school sales. For young children this means things like folders, markers, crayons, backpacks, etc. are on sale. For those who are going back to college you might see sales for books or laptops. For parents this means your schedules might change since you have to wake up earlier to get the children ready for school.

Regardless of your age and regardless of if you're going back to school or not, all of us are students of God's Word. All of us need to read and study God's Word. But as you look at the above passage you will see that the people in Isaiah's day weren't going to God's Word. Instead, they were turning to mediums and spiritists. Of course, this didn't just happen in Isaiah's day; it has happened throughout history.

But why is that? Why do you people like to consult mediums and practice some form of sorcery? I can think of one reason why people like to do this. People want to know the future and the Bible doesn't always give them the specific answers they are looking for. The Bible will not tell you who your significant other might be. The Bible does not tell you if you will be rich or not. Because of this we all might be tempted to find answers in other places. Maybe you have used a Ouija board and asked it questions. Maybe you read the horoscope in the newspaper and then live your day by what that says. Maybe you haven't done those things, but when you want an answer to your questions do you go to the Word to see what God says to you?

To the law and to the testimony! Let us always go back to the Word. Even though Scripture may not give you specific answers to your specific questions, Scripture does give you everything that you need to know. Scripture has revealed that Jesus Christ, the Word, who is God took on human flesh to save us from our sins. And Scripture also guides us in our understanding of what God wants for us and how he blesses us. So let us go back to the Word each day as God makes our faith and knowledge about him grow.

ATTENDANCE COMMUNICATION: Feel free to inform your friends and family that members are being given a fresh start with their attendance records. **Starting September 1**, the Elders will begin to lovingly address attendance concerns with individual strayed or straying members. The following timeline for contacting members will be followed, keeping in mind there may be unique circumstances requiring the Elders to assess each individual one-on-one:

- Two months: Elder phone call (or letter) of encouragement.
- Three months: Elder phone call (or letter) of concern.
- Four months: Pastor makes a contact.
- Six months: A visit by Pastor or an elder.
- Eight months: A final letter expressing our heartfelt desire for the individual to return to worship.
- Ten months: A letter informing recipient(s) of impending release.
- Twelve months: A letter of release (sent by certified mail), after congregational approval.
