Sabbath Rest

"Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor you manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy." (*Exodus 20:8-11*)

The month of September has a national holiday called Labor Day. On this day most people have a vacation day from work. It's a time when many people travel, go to family gatherings, have picnics, or just relax at home. The gift of rest and not working is something we cherish.

It's something that God also cherishes. In the above section of Scripture you will see that it mentions how God rested on the seventh day of creation. Does this mean that God actually fell asleep as if he needed rest? No, because our God does not become tired. He doesn't need rest. So what does it mean that God rested on the seventh day? It means that God stopped creating, and he blessed the seventh day making it a day of rest. That's why it's called the Sabbath Day because the Hebrew word "Sabbath" means rest.

Why did God set apart this day for a day of rest? God knows how much we need physical rest for our bodies. We can't work nonstop for if we did our bodies would no longer be able to function as well as they should. We would become filled with anxiety. We would have no joy in life if we were just working all the time. So God established a day to give us rest so that our bodies can be restored, to relieve stress, and to give us time to have joy.

But there's a bigger reason God set apart one day for rest. He set apart one day for rest so that we can find spiritual rest. Just like with our physical bodies, our spiritual lives need rest. For if we had no spiritual rest then we wouldn't be able to function as we should in our spiritual lives. We would become filled with stress and anxiety because the weight of our sins weighs us down. We would have no spiritual joy because Satan is always there accusing us of our trespasses.

So where do we find spiritual rest? We find spiritual rest in Christ. He once said, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (*Matthew 11:28-29*) Christ our Savior came to bring spiritual rest for our souls by living and dying to take away our sins. This forgiveness is offered to us from his Word which we focus on in worship. This is why we set apart one day for God's Word and worship to find spiritual rest for our souls so that our spiritual lives can be restored, so that we can be relieved of the stress of sin, and to find spiritual joy from God.

So as you all enjoy your Labor Day and any other day of rest, give praise to God that he cherishes both physical and spiritual rest for us. May you always find rest in our God who blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.


SERVICES ON THE AIR: A Christ Evangelical Lutheran
